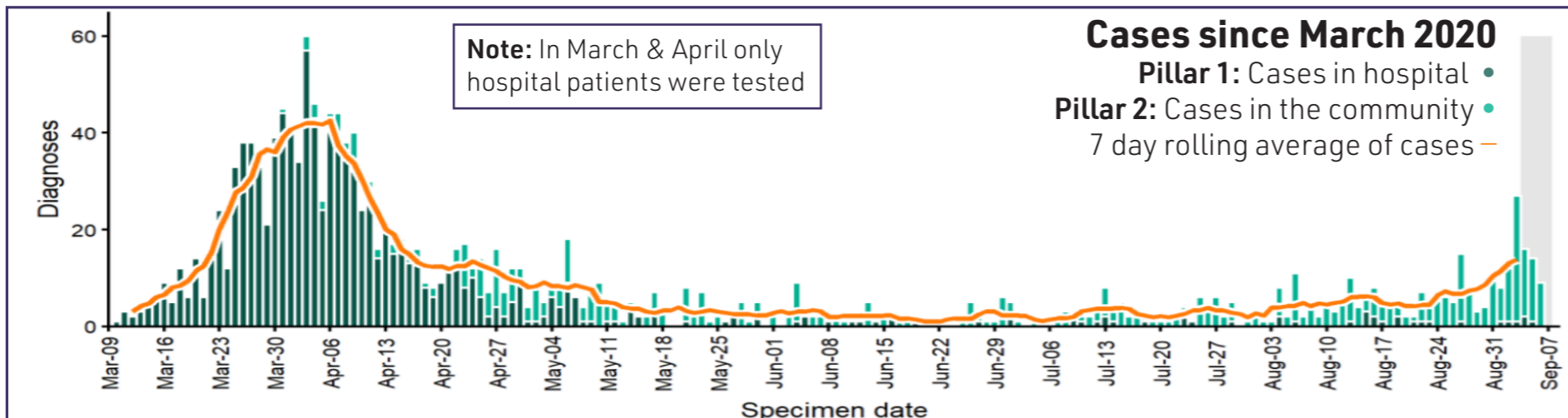


NEWHAM WEEKLY COVID-19 STATISTICS

WHAT DOES IT MEAN?

Newham has matched the country in seeing a large increases in cases in the past week, and an increase in the test positivity rate, with a doubling of the number of cases per 100,000 residents. This is a concerning trend and highlights the need for all of us across the borough to taken the necessary steps to reduce transmission. While the cases are not yet translating into hospital admissions without concerted efforts now that risk is very real.
