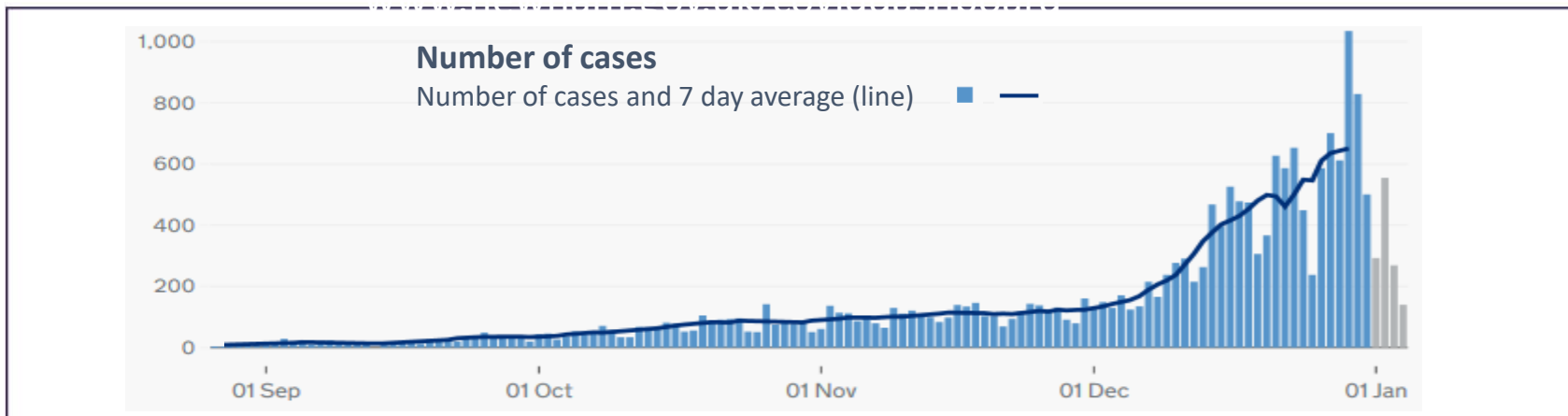


NEWHAM WEEKLY COVID-19 STATISTICS

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

This week there have been further increases in Newham cases with 4,196 people tested positive in the past 7 days. This means more than a fifth of all known cases to date occurred in just the last week. Substantial community transmission is continuing in Newham, and with very large numbers in the community becoming seriously unwell and requiring hospital treatment. Our local NHS and across all of London is under deep and mounting pressure.

Please protect yourself and your loved ones over the holiday season:

- Limit your contact with other households to an absolute minimum over the next few weeks
- Please do not visit other peoples homes other than when caring roles are necessary
- Please ensure your face is covered when going to shops or other indoor places
- If you and those you live with are required to isolate and it is difficult, please ask for help
