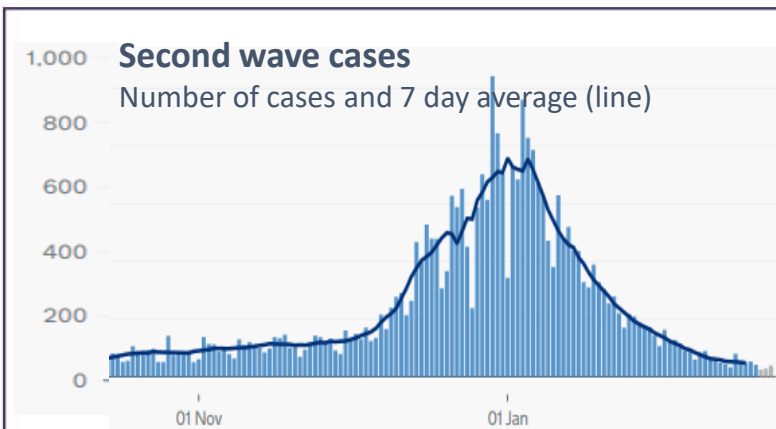


NEWHAM WEEKLY COVID-19 STATISTICS

Vaccination: first doses given up to 20th February

- 45,040 1st dose given in total (12% of Newham population). An increase of 8282 since last week. Of these:
- Cohort 1: 239 to older residents in care (92%)
- Cohort 2: 5,033 to 80+ (91.5%)
- Cohort 3: 9,951 to 75+ years (68%)
- Cohort 4: 13,607 to 70+ (89%), excluding CEV coverage
- 30,109 to under 70 years, including Cohorts 5 & 6 and frontline health and social care workforce

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new cases of Covid-19 in Newham has again fallen substantially (by 23%). Also positivity has fallen, both of which are really good news. 45,040 first dose vaccines have been given an increase by over 8,000 since last week

Community transmission continues and the new strain of Covid-19 is highly transmissible. We need to keep following all the advice and guidelines to ensure the Covid rates are as low as possible. That is the best way to protect our community and get back to more normal life.

- Please ensure your face is covered when going to shops or other indoor places.
- Ensure you isolate if you have symptoms, test positive or are a contact. Support is available.
- Tests yourself regularly if you leave the house for work or caring.
- If you have been invited for a vaccination please take it up.
