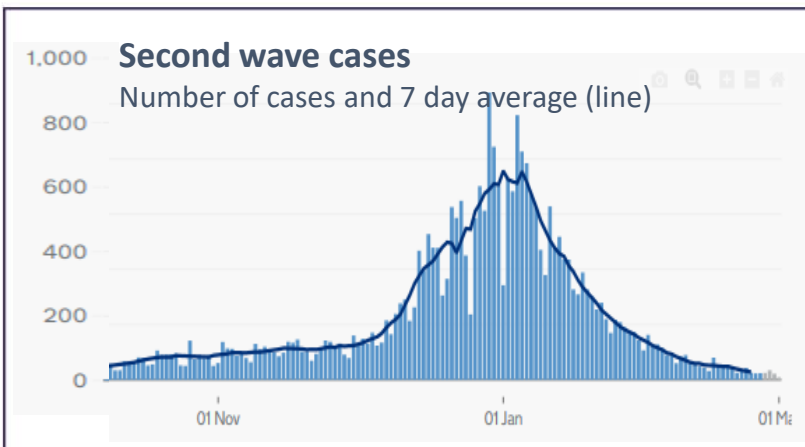


NEWHAM WEEKLY COVID-19 STATISTICS

Vaccination: First doses given up to 28 February

- 58,456 1st dose given in total (15% of Newham population). Of these:
- Cohort 1: 239 to older residents in care (92%)
- Cohort 2: 5,033 to 80+ (91.5%)
- Cohort 3: 8,240 to 75+ years (77%)
- Cohort 4: 13,636 to 70+ (77%), excluding CEV coverage
- 30,109 to under 70 years, including adults with risk conditions & frontline health and social care workforce

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new Covid-19 cases in Newham has again fallen substantially (by 38%). Positivity has also fallen, both of which are great news. 58,456 first dose vaccines have been given - an increase by over 10,000 since last week. However, community transmission continues and the new strain of Covid-19 is highly transmissible which is why we need to keep following the advice and guidelines to ensure that the rates are as low as possible. This is the best way to protect our community and get back to a more normal life.

- Please ensure your face is covered when going to shops or other indoor places.
- Ensure you isolate if you have symptoms, test positive or are a contact. Support is available.
- Test yourself regularly if you leave the house for work or caring.
- If you have been invited for a vaccination please take it up.
