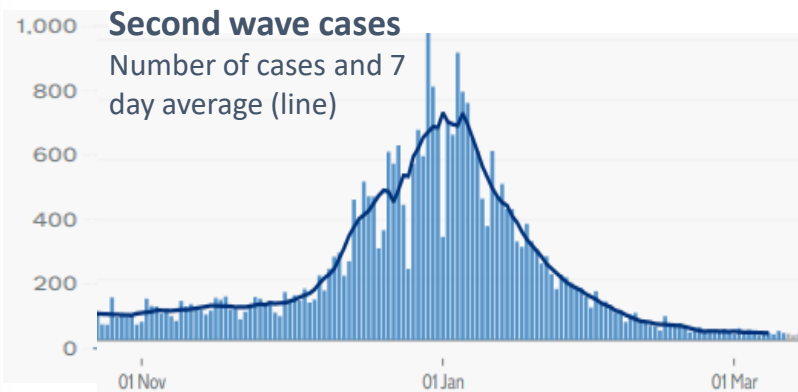


# NEWHAM WEEKLY COVID-19 STATISTICS

Updated: 17<sup>th</sup> March for period 7<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> March

**Vaccination:** First doses given up to 17<sup>th</sup> March

**78,113** first dose given (21% of population). Of these:

- Cohort 1: 239 to older residents in care (92%)
- Cohort 2: 5,033 to 80+ (91.5%)
- Cohort 3: 8,293 to 75+ years (77%)
- Cohort 4: 13,946 to 70+ (78%) and 21,893 to CEV (66%)
- 37,984 to under 70 years
- 4,251 to frontline health and social care workforce

## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new Covid-19 cases continues to fall (by 11%) to 161. Positivity has also fallen to 1.0% while testing of school pupils has increased the overall testing rate again. 78,113 first dose vaccines have been given – an increase by over 9,000 since last week.

With potentially fewer vaccines available next month, it's vital that everyone currently eligible takes up a vaccine; getting vaccinated protects the whole community and not just themselves.

Community transmission of Covid 19 remains a risk so please continue to:

- Wear a face mask when going to shops or other indoor places.
- Ensure you isolate if you have symptoms, test positive or are a contact. Support is available.
- Test yourself regularly if you leave the house for work or caring.
