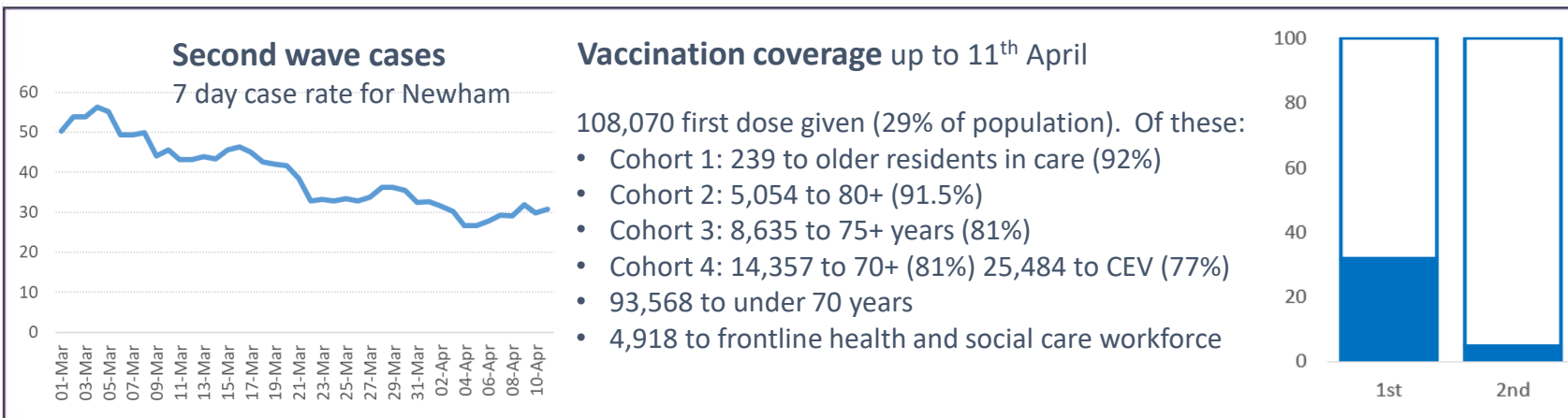

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new Covid-19 cases has remained static this week. Testing has fallen slightly while positivity has increased very slightly. 108,070 first dose and 15,699 second dose vaccines have been given (up to 11 April).

It's vital that everyone currently eligible gets a vaccine when offered; getting vaccinated protects the whole community and not just yourself.

Community transmission of Covid-19 remains a risk
