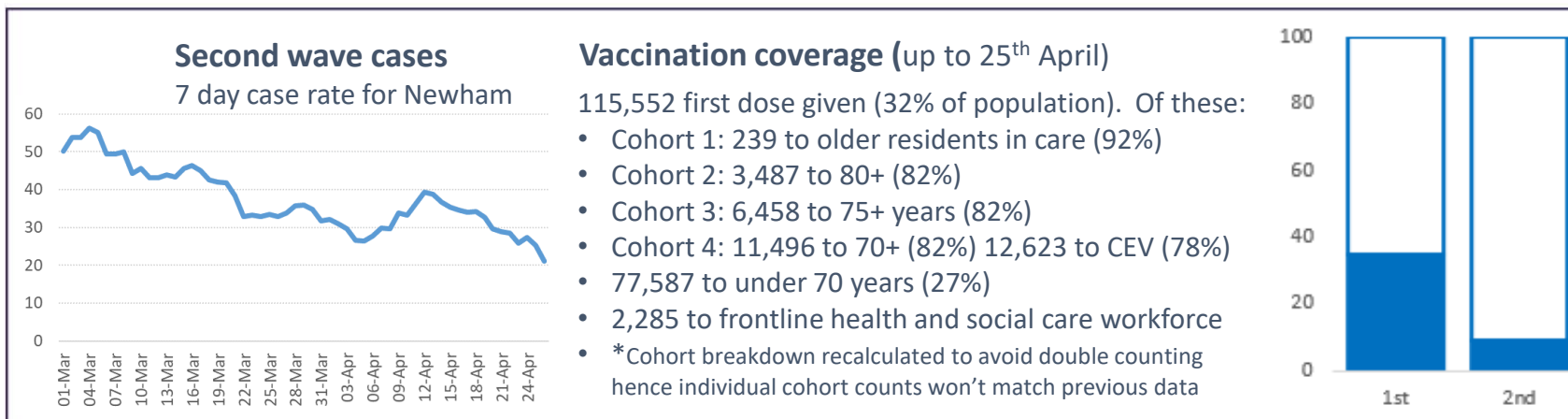


# NEWHAM WEEKLY COVID-19 STATISTICS

## WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new Covid-19 cases has fallen further this week to 100. Testing has risen very slightly with a small fall in positivity. 115,552 first dose and 28,963 second dose vaccines have been given (up to 25<sup>th</sup> April).
