




Vaccination coverage (up to 6th June 2021)

149,692 1st dose given (44% of population). Of these:

- Cohorts 1 to 5 (70+ yrs): 34,703 (80%)
- Cohort 6 Covid at risk: 10,835 (67%)
- Cohorts 7 & 8 (55-64 yrs): 18,869 (71%)
- Cohorts 9 & 10 (40-54 yrs): 44,560 (58%)
- Cohorts 11 to 13 (<40 yrs): 39,236 (23%)

85,681 2nd dose have been give (25% of population).

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new Covid-19 cases is now rising again with 125 cases this week.

149,692 first dose and 85,681 second dose vaccines have now been given (up to 6th June), and most adults are now eligible.

It is vital that everyone currently eligible gets a vaccine when offered; and their second dose when eligible. Getting vaccinated protects your loved ones and not just yourself. Book yours at www.newham.gov.uk/bookyourvaccine
