


Vaccination coverage (up to 25th July 2021)

197,750 1st dose given (58% of population). Of these:

- Cohorts 1 to 5 (65+ yrs): 35,287 (82%)
- Cohort 6 Covid at risk: 11,897 (70%)
- Cohorts 7 & 8 (55-64 yrs): 19,368 (73%)
- Cohorts 9 & 10 (40-54 yrs): 48,240 (63%)
- Cohorts 11 to 13 (<40 yrs): 81,369 (47%)

142,426 2nd dose have been given (40% of population).

ONS population estimates give 1st dose: 71% 2nd dose: 51%

WHAT DOES THIS MEAN?

The number of new COVID-19 cases has fallen with 939 cases this week in line with national changes to the rate of new cases.

197,750 first dose and 142,426 second dose vaccines have now been given (up to 25th July), and most adults are now eligible.

It is vital that everyone currently eligible gets a vaccine when offered; and their second dose when eligible. Getting vaccinated protects your loved ones and not just yourself. Book yours at www.newham.gov.uk/bookyourvaccine
