Ukrainian Family Scheme (UK Government)



The Ukraine Family Scheme is a programme that helps Ukrainians to join family members. It is free to apply, and it will allow you to live, work and study in the UK and access public funds (e.g. benefits).

Homes for Ukraine



People, charities, community groups and businesses in the UK can apply to have a named Ukrainian or Ukrainian family to stay with them in their home or in a separate property for at least 6 months. If you want to be a sponsor but don't know anyone personally fleeing Ukraine, you can also record your interest in being a sponsor. Sponsors must not charge rent but will be eligible for an optional 'thank you' payment of £350 per month. To apply visit:

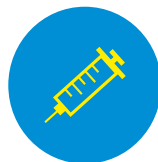
