#### **ELECTION OF MAYOR**

On Thursday 5 May 2022 voters in Newham will directly elect the Mayor of Newham and 66 councillors, who will form the next council for this borough for the next four years. It is important to make sure you make the time to vote because people elected are responsible for representing you at a local level. This booklet includes introductions from candidates for Mayor of Newham who chose to introduce themselves. The order they appear in was decided by a ballot.

To make it easier for you to cast your vote, please be aware of the following:

- Polling stations will open on Thursday 5 May 2022 from 7am – 10pm
- You can find out where your polling station is by visiting www.newham. gov.uk/voting-newham/pollingstation-finder
- The ballot papers used for the Mayor of Newham election will be pink coloured.
- The ballot paper will feature two columns. When casting your vote you will be asked to place an 'x' in the left-hand column against the candidate who is your first choice and an 'x' in the right hand column for your second choice candidate.

If you only mark a first choice, your vote will still be counted – you can choose not to make a second choice.

 The deadline for those who wish to submit a new application for a postal vote is Tuesday 19 April 2022, 5pm.

#### How are the votes counted?

The first preferences are counted, and if a candidate has received more than 50% of the votes cast they are elected.

If no candidate has more than 50% of the vote, all candidates apart from those in the first and second place are eliminated.

The votes showing a first preference for one of the eliminated candidates are checked for their second preference. Any second preference votes for the two remaining candidates are then added to their first preference votes and the candidates with most votes wins and is declared Mayor of Newham. My election team and I look forward to a very successful day.

### New, top quality, genuinely affordable social housing

Conservatives will not shy away from the housing crisis. Conservatives will speed up the local planning process and we will do all we can at a local level to stop developers sitting on land without building on it, without incurring financial penalties. Conservatives will push for more resources for our police and build relationships between the police, businesses and communities to tackle crime and support those who want to live in a peaceful and safe borough.

### Reviving our high streets and shopping parades

Our high streets are the lifeblood of local communities. Conservatives will fight for significant reform to business rates to see a reduction to help independent shops. We will seek to limit the number of betting shops and conduct a thorough review of parking across the borough to ensure residents and businesses are not punished.

### Newham: the second worst recycling rate in England

Current recycling rules are confusing and complicated resulting in much unnecessary spoilage and waste. Conservatives will be committed to making recycling rules simpler and clearer and we will introduce food waste recycling and increase the number of recycling facilities.



In terms of education in Newham, Simeon has already provided a not-for-profit supplementary school in Newham - it's still going strong 22 years later. Close to 4000 Newham children have benefited. He is presently the Chairman of Newham partnership for complementary schools in Newham.

According to Trust for London 2022 publication: "Half of Newham children (50%) are judged to be in households in poverty, compared to 37% in the typical London borough." The problem in Newham is generational and is due to poor leadership and lack of effective opposition in our council.

If Simeon is elected as your Mayor he will provide financial incentives to encourage small business and give them free parking spaces.

He has the business experience to greatly improve Newham's council services.




