Dear residents and businesses,

Sidings Intersection Link Project – Sidings Street & Montfichet Road

Newham Council will deliver new pedestrian and cycle link between Sidings Street and Montfichet Road (formerly called Pool Loop Link). Currently, pedestrians and cyclists are using the path under the Montfichet Road Bridge, which is an indirect link.

During major events at London Stadium, some of the pedestrians have been climbing over the bridge fencing between Sidings Street and Montfichet Road, which is dangerous and unsafe. A metal fence has been installed to prevent illegal crossing at this location. The new access point will be designed so that safe crowd management can be achieved during major events.

The scheme is being fully funded by the London Legacy Development Corporation (LLDC).

We are preparing to undertake the works from **27 June 2022 to 26 August 2022**.

During these works there will be a lane closure (including temporary traffic lights) in place at Montfichet Road near Pool Street and Sidings Street. Signs will be placed to show the pedestrians and cyclists diversion.

We appreciate your patience and understanding whilst the Council delivers the new link and for pedestrians and cyclists at this location.
