If the time has come that you are thinking about renting your own place, but you are not sure where to start, then the Welcome Newham Team can help! We will be hosting Private Rental Scheme information sessions in both English and Ukrainian for people who would like more information about how to rent their own property. During these sessions we will cover the items below and there will be a chance to ask questions afterwards.

Some of the things that we will cover in the session include:

- How Newham Council is able to support you when the time comes to move to the private rented sector
- Guidance that can help you navigate the private housing sector maximising the likelihood of success
- Advice on the challenges you may face when you transition to living in the private rented sector

Caramel Rock is a fashion and creative arts education charity based in Newham who will be providing free training and opportunities to refugees and asylum seekers.

Brief overview of course offer:

Course price: FREE

What it is: 6 month fashion course, learn skills to assist you to enter the fashion industry. You will be required to attend 3 days a week, Tues, Weds and Thurs, 10am – 3pm and the age criteria is 16 – 25 year olds (+)

No previous skills required. There is no set term start date, you will be able to start the week after applying.

We have **10 spaces available**

Previous participants have gone into jobs via introductions from Caramel rock to companies they have relationships with like **ASOS, Nike** etc

Basic language skills required – an assessment will be carried out beforehand to make sure the course is suitable for you.
