


## Autism Strategic Delivery Board (ASDB) Co-chair Easy Read Role Description

Newham Council are looking for a resident co- chair for the ASDB meetings.	autism
As Resident Co-chair, you will work with Newham Council and East London Foundation Trust (ELFT) staff to plan and run the Autism Strategic Delivery Board for 12 months. After 12 months, a new resident co-chair will take over to give others the opportunity.	



<ul> <li>Who can be a co-chair?</li> <li>Newham Resident, aged 18+ with an autism diagnosis and</li> <li>A member of the Autism Resident Advisory Group (ARAG) and</li> <li>Commit to the role for 12 months, must attend the meetings at least every 3 months</li> </ul>	age range
You do not need previous experience. We will support you in the role	
<ul> <li>Who will support the co-chair?</li> <li>The council will support the resident co-chair by: <ul> <li>Meeting with you to discuss the Autism Action Plan</li> <li>Answer any questions you have</li> <li>Discuss suitable meeting dates and times</li> <li>Support you in preparing for the co-chair role</li> </ul> </li> <li>As a resident co-chair you will also support the ELFT co-chair in preparing for the meetings in advance.</li> </ul>	Newham London

Does a co-chair get paid? Yes. You will receive payment. In line with the Council's Co-Production Reward and Recognition Policy, you will receive a payment of £13.15 an hour (London Living Wage) in exchange for your time	
<ul> <li>The 6 hours input you provide will cover:</li> <li>Up to 1 x hour to review papers and prepare for meetings.</li> <li>Up to 3 x hours to attend the meeting itself including travel time.</li> <li>Up to 1 x hour follow up / preparation time.</li> <li>Up to 1 x hour to meet with the Autism Team as required every three months</li> <li>You can claim the payment every 3 months (4 times a year)</li> </ul>	VOUCHER
<ul> <li>How do I apply?</li> <li>Telling us a little about yourself, your experiences, skills and what you can bring to the role</li> <li>A maximum of 600 words</li> <li>Email us before the deadline at: <u>Autism.Commissioning@newham.gov.uk</u></li> </ul>	apply 1 2 3 4
