Protests

Protests involving the release of black balloons have taken place at every game, both home and away, so far.

Discussions continued regarding concerns about skaters and their impact on public safety during egress for both football and non-football events. These concerns have been brought to the attention of the Borough Resilience Group and Community Safety teams. A working group has been established to address the issue and develop a focused response, with SSAG members invited to participate. EK will escalate further issues addressed at the working group to BECC.

Stewards are reminded that standing is in violation of licence regulations.
