Energy Efficiency update

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What is retrofit

Retrofit is the term that is given to any improvements made to a property that improve its **Energy Efficiency**, therefore making it cheaper to heat and more comfortable to live in.

The key principle of retrofit is that the needs of every property are different and therefore each property needs to be considered individually. There is no "one size fits all retrofit".

Minimum Energy Efficiency Standards 2015 1st April 2018 – New tenancies


Renting out an F or G rated property

Upcoming support – Warm Homes Local Grant



- £15,000 energy performance cost cap per included property that can be averaged across the application
 - Insulation
 - Draughtproofing
 - Double Glazing
 - Energy Efficient doors
 - Solar PV
 - Smart Controls
 - Battery storage
- £15,000 low carbon heat cost cap per included property

Eligibility: (tenants that meet one of)

Pathway 1: Households in Indices Multiple Deprivation (IMD) Decile 1-2 (Eligible Areas shown later)

Pathway 2: Households that are in receipt of means tested benefits

Pathway 3: Households with an annual gross income below £36,000 or below the 'after housing cost' threshold


And

EPC D-G

- First property is fully funded, free to the landlord
- Any subsequent properties owned by the same landlord will require 50% landlord contribution
- No restriction on how many properties the Landlord can own

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Eligible Postcodes



2026 of the eligible postcodes are in Newham

This means that all properties that have EPC D-G in these postcodes are automatically eligible

Using the most recent EPC data from August 24 over 13,000 properties are eligible through this route in Newham
