A licence can be issued for up to 3 days per single site and is not for multiple locations. Upon receipt of this application you will be advised of the total fees payable.

Payment can be made by Credit or Debit Card or by BACS (payment details will be on the payment invoice provided). Please note that we do not charge V.A.T. on Highway's Act Licences and we do not issue V.A.T. receipts.

Upon receipt a preliminary inspection of the site will be undertaken and if approved a licence will be issued allowing the use of mobile apparatus subject to a number of conditions, which will form part of the licence itself, and which will vary from site to site. Failure to adhere to these conditions will result in withdrawal of the licence.


Placing of the mobile apparatus may not commence prior to the receipt of the licence.
