Accommodation and Housing



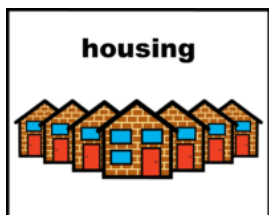
1. Review the Floating Support offer for residents with Learning Disabilities.

3. Review and refocus the Supported Living at Ranelagh Road.



4. A Supported Accommodation Strategy is being written. It will have a chapter on Learning Disability and Autism.

Support ILSS (Independent Living Support Services) to help the people they support connect with each other develop Friendship Circles.



Finish work on the Sex and Relationships Policy for in-borough accommodation-based Providers.



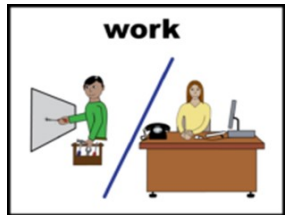
Our Newham Learning and Skills will develop an action.

Our Newham Work to build the connections between Adult Services and their Service

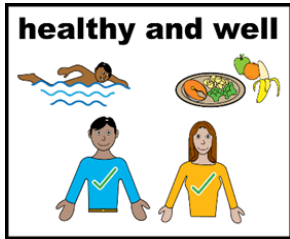


Develop a few Apprenticeships in Construction for People with Learning Disabilities. To be paid for with Social Value funds.



Community Opportunities Team (Newham) to take over the shop at Newham Dockside and provide training in retail.

Health and Social Care



Deliver a Learning Disability specific Healthy Weight Project.



Review the environment and support offered to patients who have Learning Disabilities at Newham Centre for Mental Health.



The East London Foundation Trust (ELFT) will set up an Employment Forum.

This will promote training programmes and increase the number of people with learning disabilities in the workforce.

Health and Social Care



Health and Social Care to improve how they fund packages together.



Empower staff to have End of Life conversations.



ELFT has Cancer Screening priority work.

Healthwatch Newham project to be delivered regarding Health Screening Uptake. Including accessible materials and enabling choice.

Carers



Newham wants to look at it's respite offer.



Identify people who are not using planned respite who have:

- Unpaid Carers giving 35+ hours of care and support per week;
- people who have Profound and multiple learning disabilities.



Work has started to identify Carers 50 years or older.
This will help with long term and emergency planning.
